To help everyone fully participate in the liturgy, an induction hearing loop is installed in the church. If your hearing aid or cochlear processor has a **Telecoil ('T-switch')**, simply activate it when you arrive. This cuts out background echoes and brings the priest's voice and music directly to your device.

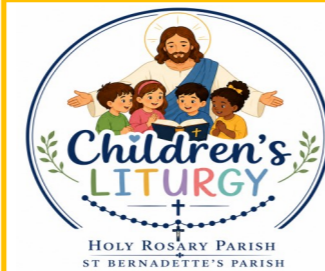

Down & Connor Diocesan Novena to The Sacred Heart

June 4th to June 12th, the feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

It is with great joy as a Diocese we celebrate the Novena to The Sacred Heart. The Sacred Heart Novena invites you to nine days of prayer, cumulating in the celebration of the Feast of the Sacred Heart. **Come to Me.** These words of Jesus are among the most tender in all of the Gospels. They are not a command but an invitation - offered freely, offered personally, offered to each one of us.

To set aside time each day for prayer is to say yes to that invitation.

It is a simple act, yet a profound one. In the busyness of our lives - with all their demands, their joys, and their anxieties - to pause and turn our hearts toward Jesus is itself a form of love.

The prayers will be available in a booklet you can pick up at Mass or read online; it will also include a piece of scripture and a reflection for each day for those who wish to go a little deeper. Bishop Alan's hope is that this novena will be prayed either individually or together by parishes, groups, schools or families.

Even young children can join in with the short prayers!

One way that we, in the parishes of Holy Rosary and St. Bernadette's and others who may wish to join us, will respond to Jesus' words "Come to Me" is by praying the Novena in the Good Shepherd church, which, before becoming the parish church for Holy Rosary parish, was dedicated in 1920 to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

This time of prayer and reflection will take place each evening of the Novena i.e. Thursday 4th June to Friday 12th June, in the church of the Good Shepherd from 7.30p.m. to 8p.m.

The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed during this time of prayer, and we will conclude with Benediction.
