

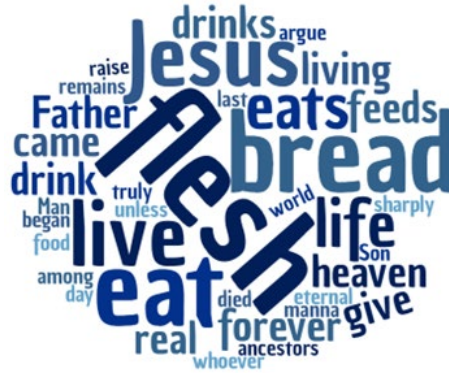

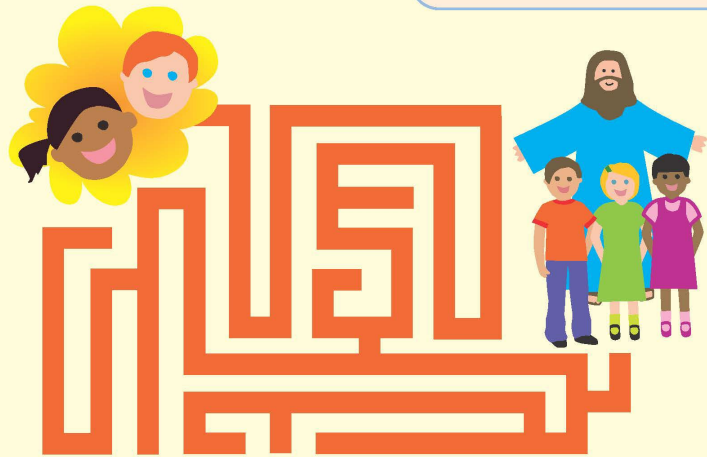

300ml Warm W _ _ _ _

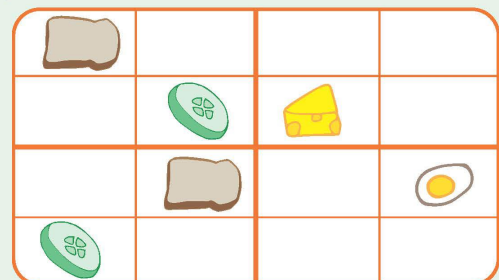
2tsp S _ _ _
