First Reading (Numbers 6:22-27) In our first reading we find the priestly blessing from the Book of Numbers: an ancient blessing still used in Jewish Synagogue services today, long since adopted by Christians. It is a blessing we might also use at home.

Second Reading (Galatians 4:4-7) We are sons and daughters of God; brothers and sisters in faith. Out identity as God's children has implications for who we are and how we live.

Gospel Reading (Luke 2:16-21) Formerly the Feast of the Circumcision, today now has a broader focus, centring on the role of Mary in her capacity as mother, treasuring all these things and pondering them in her heart.

Calendar of Feasts

Friday 6th. January is the Feast of the Epiphany. This is a Holy Day of Obligation. The Vigil Mass will be on Thursday at 7.30p.m. and at 10a.m. on Friday.

"Epiphany" means a "showing" or 'revelation' and, at this time, we are remembering and celebrating three 'revelations' or 'showings' of God: Christmas, today's feast, and the Baptism of Jesus in the Jordan River.



Next Friday is the First Friday of the month. The sick, housebound, and those Parishioners who are in hospital and nursing homes will be attended by the priest during the coming week.

Eucharistic Adoration

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament resumes next Tuesday in the Lourdes Chapel from 8a.m. until 7.15p.m. Why not drop in for a few minutes of quiet reflection, away from the rush and strain of daily life, and say a silent prayer or simply just sit and rest in the very presence of the Lord?

Golden Jubilee



2017 marks the 50th. Anniversary of the opening of St. Bernadette's Church. The foundation stone was laid on Wednesday 8th. September 1965. The formal dedication was on Sunday 29th. October 1967 by Bishop William Philbin D.D. The Parish Priest was Canon Daniel Murphy P.P.V.F. with Fr. Liam Mullan, the first priest in residence at St. Bernadette's. The church had been designed to cater for the large influx of catholics into the Ormeau/Rosetta area and to relieve pressure on the old Holy Rosary Church on the Ormeau Road. On Sunday 28th. February 1988, the Parish of St. Bernadette was formally established. The first Parish Priest was Fr. Fred MacSorley. Plans are in progress to mark this special year with a number of events. This information will be published in the coming weeks and it is hoped that Parishioners and friends of St. Bernadette's will join in the celebrations.
