First Reading (Acts 1:1-11) Jesus has completed the task given to him by his heavenly Father and he returns to the Father. This is the focus of our reflections on the Feast of the Ascension. Christians believe that Jesus was both divine and human – although those who do not believe in God cannot recognise the divinity of Jesus. Consequently, they are unlikely to accept that he ascended to heaven at the end of his earthly life. Yet Christians affirm every time they recite the Creed that he did precisely that.

Second Reading (Ephesians 1:17-23) Paul prays for the Ephesians that they may have wisdom and knowledge so that they can appreciate more fully the mystery of the death and resurrection of Christ. It is surely appropriate that we pray for the same wisdom and knowledge so that we can benefit from the death and resurrection of Christ in our lives.

Gospel Reading (Matthew 28:16-20) Before returning to his Father in heaven, Jesus told his disciples to continue his saving activity. First, they were to make disciples of all nations. They were commissioned to lead people to conversion. Secondly, they were to baptise people in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Thirdly, they were to teach those who were baptised to observe all that Jesus had taught during his earthly ministry. © Intercom 2017



Marian Devotion

A specially-commissioned icon of **Our** Lady of Perpetual Help will be installed at Our Lady's Shrine in the church and will be blessed by Bishop Farguhar at the 7.30p.m. Mass on Tuesday.

The icon features the child Jesus fleeing into his Mother's protective arms as the Archangels Michael and Gabriel show Him the instruments of crucifixion. The Greek letters spell out the first letters of Mary and Jesus' names.

The origin of the icon is unknown. Many have thought that St. Luke painted it, but its existence prior to the late Middle Ages cannot be confirmed. Likely it is Eastern in origin due to the Byzantine style and Greek lettering.
