The second collection this weekend is the Easter Voluntary Collection, for the support of the priests.

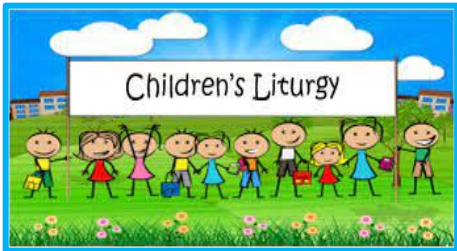
The Monthly Stipend Collection for the support of the priests will be taken up next weekend (7th April)
