

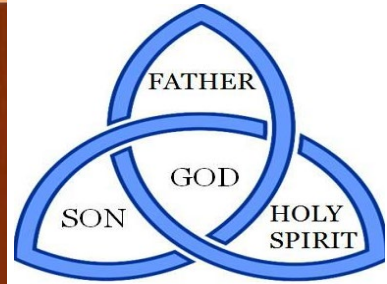

JUNE 19TH TO JUNE 27TH,
THE FEAST OF THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS.**

A message from Bishop Alan

'It is with great joy as a diocese we celebrate the Novena to The Sacred Heart. This year we celebrate the 350th Anniversary of the apparitions of the Sacred Heart to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque. The Sacred Heart Novena invites you to nine days of prayer, cumulating in the celebration of the Feast of the Sacred Heart. These days offer a special opportunity to deepen your relationship with Jesus, to entrust your needs and intentions to His loving heart, a prayerful expression of our hope in this Jubilee Year.'

The prayers will be available in a booklet you can pick up at Mass or read online; it will also include a piece of scripture and a reflection for each day for those who wish to go a little deeper. The images used in this year's Novena book are by students from our schools from across the diocese. Bishop Alan's hope is that this novena will be prayed either individually or together by parishes, groups, schools or families. Even young children can join in with the short prayers!

We, in the parishes of Holy Rosary and St. Bernadette's and others who may wish to join us, will be praying the Novena in the Good Shepherd church, which, before becoming the parish church for Holy Rosary Parish, was dedicated in 1920 to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

This time of prayer and reflection, which will continue each evening of the Novena, starts on Thursday 19th June, and will end on Friday 27th June, in the church of the Good Shepherd from 7.30pm to 8pm.

The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed during this time of prayer, and we will conclude with Benediction.

Jesus promises the disciples to send the Holy Spirit who will teach them the truth. Fill in the blanks to find out the truth.

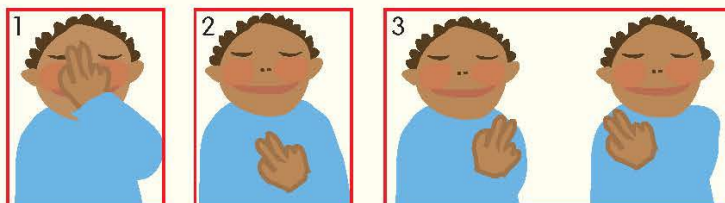
