In this reading, he condemns the exploitation of the poor. He warns his listeners to treat others justly and to be aware of the evils of greed – a message which is as pertinent today as it was in the time of Amos.

Second Reading (1 Timothy 2:1-8) Paul encourages us in this passage from his first letter to Timothy to think of others and to pray for them, especially for those in authority – again, this advice applies as much in the world we live in today as it did when Paul wrote this letter to Timothy.

Gospel Reading (Luke 16:1-13 - Shorter version 16:10-13) In today's Gospel, we hear Jesus tell us frankly that we cannot be slaves to God and money. He invites us to make definite and prudent choices about which master to follow in our lives. Each of us are stewards of the gifts God has given to us and Jesus gently but firmly reminds us that we have a great responsibility entrusted to us to use those gifts properly and faithfully.

Reflection

We need to be constantly reminded that we are the stewards and never the owners of what we possess. We have no absolute right to anything we have. "I can do what I like with my money and property because it's mine" is not a statement any committed Christian can make. So the question of a successful life is not "How much did you make?" but "How did you use what you had to creative purposes for the general welfare of all?"
