First Reading (Isaiah 8:23-9:3) His faith in God prompts him to optimism about the future: the people who walked in darkness have seen a great light. Shadows are dispelled, joy and gladness shine out. Good will triumph over evil in the end.

Second Reading (1 Corinthians 1:10-13,17) The Church at Corinth has lost its way. The cult of personality and sectional rivalries threaten to tear the community apart. Paul steers them back to their unity in Christ.

Gospel Reading (Matthew 4:12-23) Jesus leaves Nazareth and settles in Capernaum, a lakeside town. With his uncompromising call to repentance, perhaps he already senses the early tide of opposition and the wave of hostility that will finally nail him to the cross.

Do This In Memory

The "**Do This In Memory**" Programme for children, who are preparing to receive their First Holy Communion in May, begins this **Sunday** at the 10a.m. Mass. "Do This in Memory" is designed to take place within the context of the Sunday Parish celebration of the Eucharist offering parents, guardians, children and the Parish community the opportunity to prepare together for First Communion. It is then continued in the home through the use of activities and resources for both parents, guardians, and children.

This highlights the importance of the Sunday Eucharist as a place where we gather, are nourished by the Word and the Bread of Life, and are sent forth to live the **Gospel**. It also acknowledges the home as the most important and significant place, where the faith of our children is nurtured, nourished and sustained.

Holy Communion



The most important occasion for Catholics happens each time we receive our Lord in Holy Communion. In Holy Communion, we are eating the True Body and Blood of Jesus Christ, without which "vou shall not have life in you" (John 6:53). Great care must be taken to receive the Sacred Host with reverence and respect.

Receiving the Host in the Hand

To indicate clearly that you intend to receive in your hands, you should have your hands in this position already as you approach the Priest or Extraordinary Minister of Eucharist. The proper way to receive the Host is to place one hand flat on top of the other so that the open palm is facing upward. Once the Host has been placed onto your palm, step to the side and consume it immediately by taking it with the fingers of the lower hand and placing the Host in your mouth. It is not appropriate to take the Host with your mouth directly from your open palm. It is recommended that children should not receive by hand until they have received the Sacrament of Confirmation.
