Laudato Si' Week Saturday May 24th - Saturday May 31st

In his Pastoral Letter, Bishop Alan encourages us with a heart full of hope and a deep sense of urgency. This special week, inspired by the late Pope Francis' encyclical Laudato Si': On Care for Our Common Home, invites us to reflect on the beauty of God's creation and our sacred responsibility to protect it and protect the poorest whose livelihoods depend on the fruit of their labours. Our world is crying out-from the forests that bum, to the oceans that rise, to the communities that suffer most from environmental degradation. Yet, amid these challenges, we are reminded that hope is born from action, and that each of us has a role to play in healing our common home. Let us be inspired by the words of Pope Francis: "Living our vocation to be protectors of God's handiwork is essential to a life of virtue; it is not an optional or a secondary aspect of our Christian experience". May this Laudato Si' Week be a time of renewal for our faith and our commitment to justice, peace, and the integrity of creation. Let us walk gently on the Earth, with gratitude in our hearts and courage in our steps.

Inspired by our late Pope Francis' vision for a **Jubilee Year of Hope**, we'll explore how our Catholic faith calls us to embody hope in these challenging times. Speakers include Bishop Alan McGuckian SJ, Dr Austen Ivereigh, and Julieann Moran. The event will be chaired by Pat Coyle of Jesuit Communications. Engage in Spirit-led conversations to foster hope in our families, faith communities and world. All are welcome.
