Today is the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, twin founders of the Church in Rome

It is the day traditionally considered in pagan Rome to be its foundation day by Romulus.

Although Paul had occasion to stand up to Peter because he would not eat with Gentiles – 'I opposed him to his face, since he was manifestly in the wrong' (Gal 2:11) – they are both jointly honoured on this feast. Today is a day when the Pope confers the pallium on all the archbishops whom he has appointed in the previous year. The conversion of St Paul is celebrated on 25th January.
