

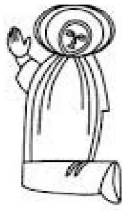

COVID-19 & FACE MASKS IN CHURCH

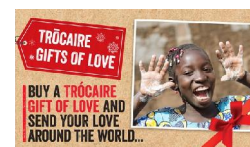
